The standard promotes care for something that is not our property, by involving stakeholders and acting not only within the company, but also within the river basin (and beyond), emphasizing the importance of the availability of fresh drinking water.

AWS implementation encourages, recognizes and value good water resources management practices and supports:

- Understanding process dependencies and impacts on water resources
- Reducing the impact of operational and water-related risks throughout the production cycle (from raw material to finished product)
- Establishment of programs for responsible water resources management
- Building relationships with local stakeholders
- Addressing common challenges with stakeholders

Pivara Skopje AD is the first company in the country, among 200 companies in the world, which in 2020 was certified according to the Alliance for Water Stewardship standard, with the highest level of achievement "Platinum certificate"















Company water resources governance includes:

- Focus on water consumption in each step of the production process and its optimization
- Involvement of the **Leadership Teams** in achieving the goals of the standard
- Involvement of all employees in continuous monitoring of water losses through "Near loss" program
- Continuous training of employees to raise awareness of the importance of water
- An open platform for sharing ideas for improvement projects
